



Westaway Storm sails are not off the shelf, they are custom designed and cut individually to suit the deck and spars. Badly setting Storm Sails are a liability not what you need when your life or your children's life depends on it! Westaway take comprehensive measurements and computer design our Storm Sails just like all other sails and they are built here at our lyybridge loft. The seams have at least 3 rows of 3-step anti snag stitching for ultimate reliability. Westaway can design the sail to sheet to the spinnaker sheet blocks allowing the sail to be

used independent of the boom, or if on a lee shore or racing and the sail is required to sail to windward a reef line can be used as an outhaul onto the main boom allowing the sail to be close winded, therefore increasing efficiency. A rope or wire strop is spliced to the tack to raise the tack above stored mainsail. Available in High Visability orange or top quality premium white rip stop fabric with a large contrasting stripe across the sail. Our Storm sails conform to ISAF, ORC and Charter Coding safety regulations.
